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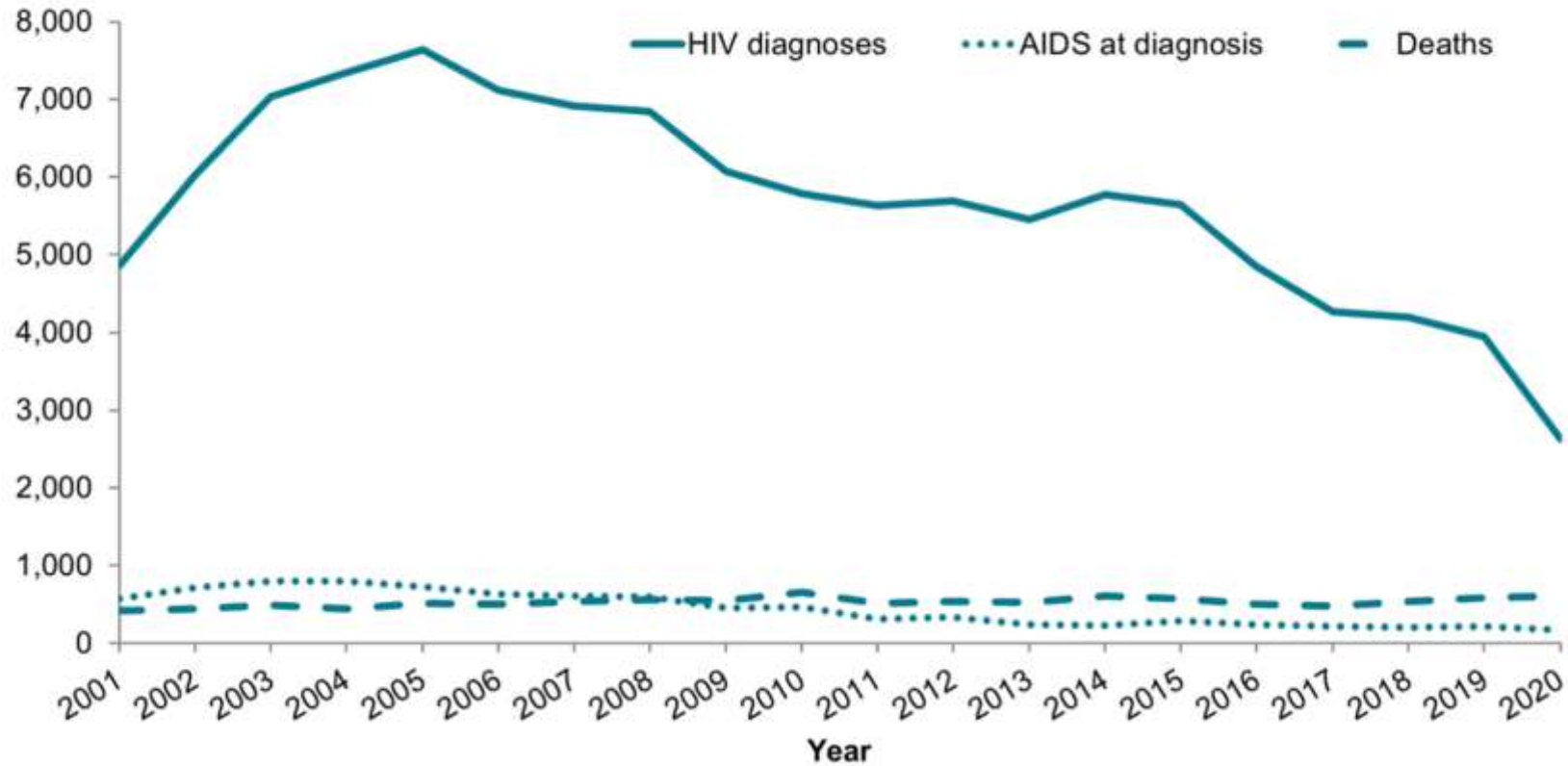

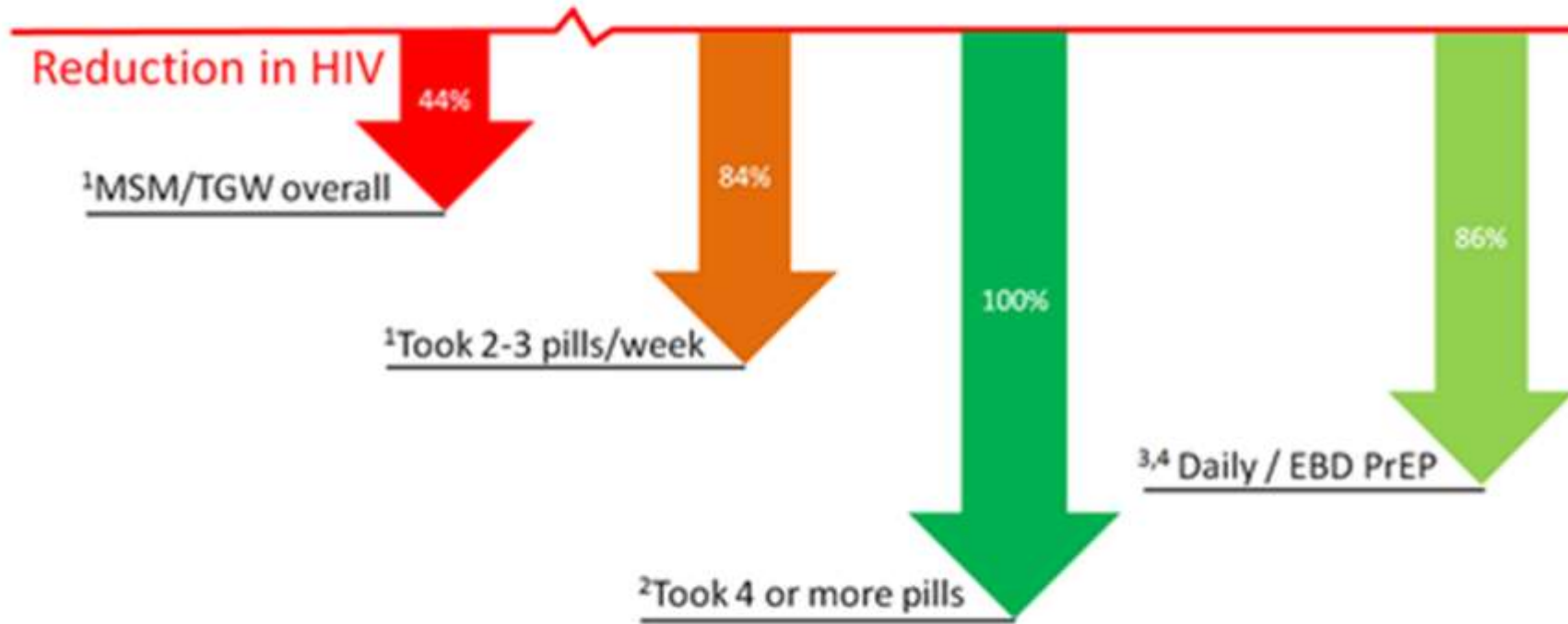

Figure 6. New HIV diagnoses, AIDS at diagnosis, and all-cause deaths in people with HIV: England, 2001 to 2020



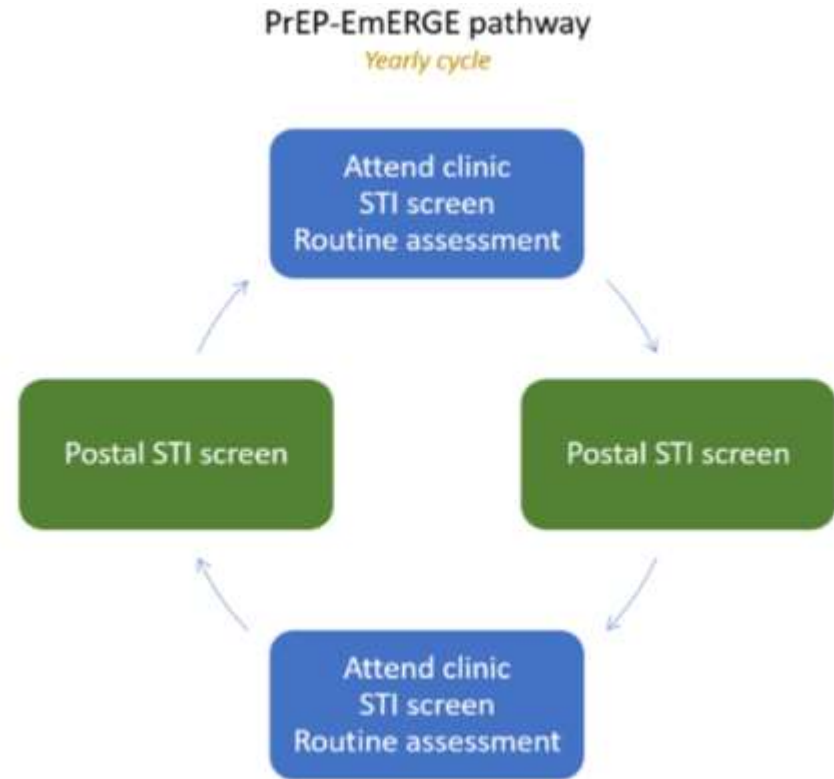
HIV PrEP in MSM & TGW

- Recognised health inequalities

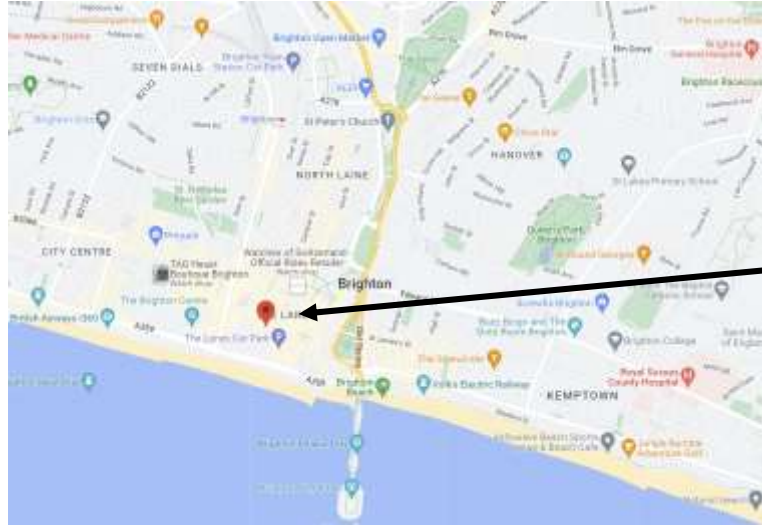




PrEP2U Aims:

- Provide seamless interactions





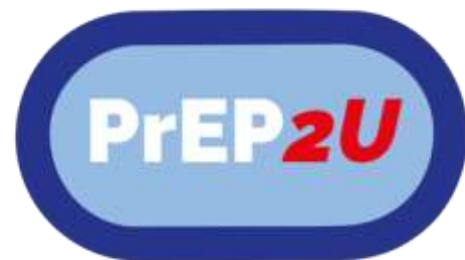
THT Support worker:

SHAC Clinical Worker:

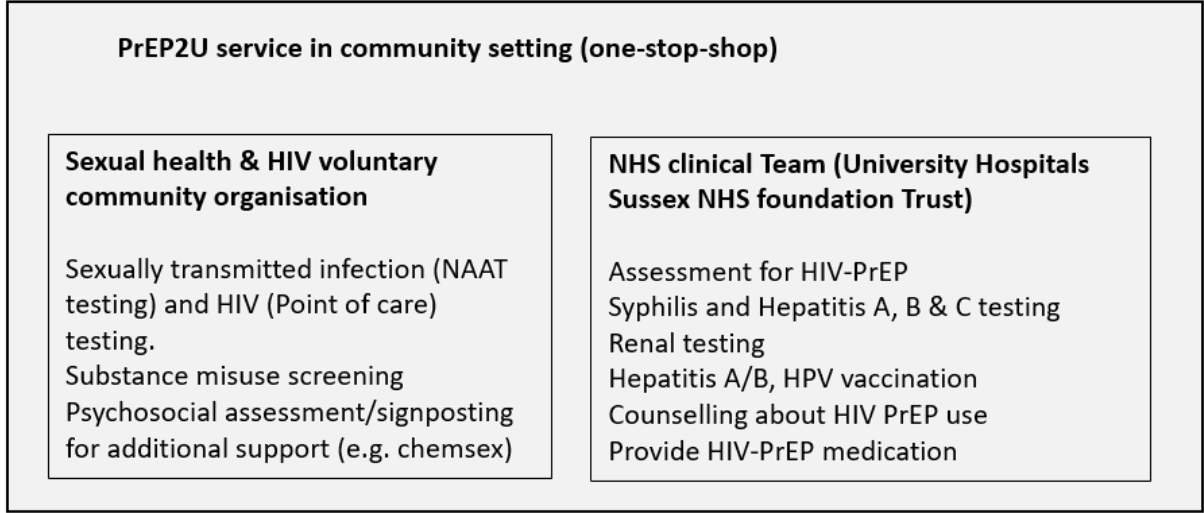
- Phlebotomy

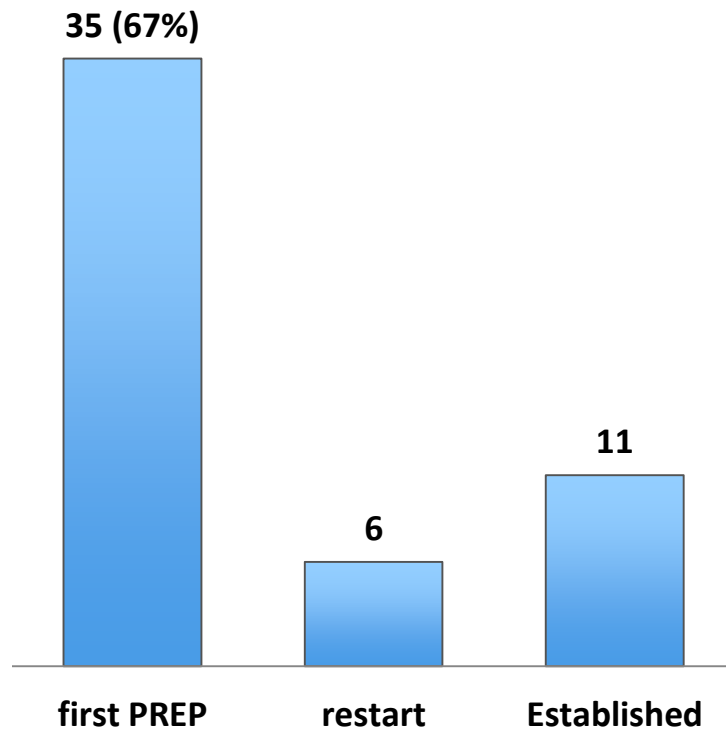




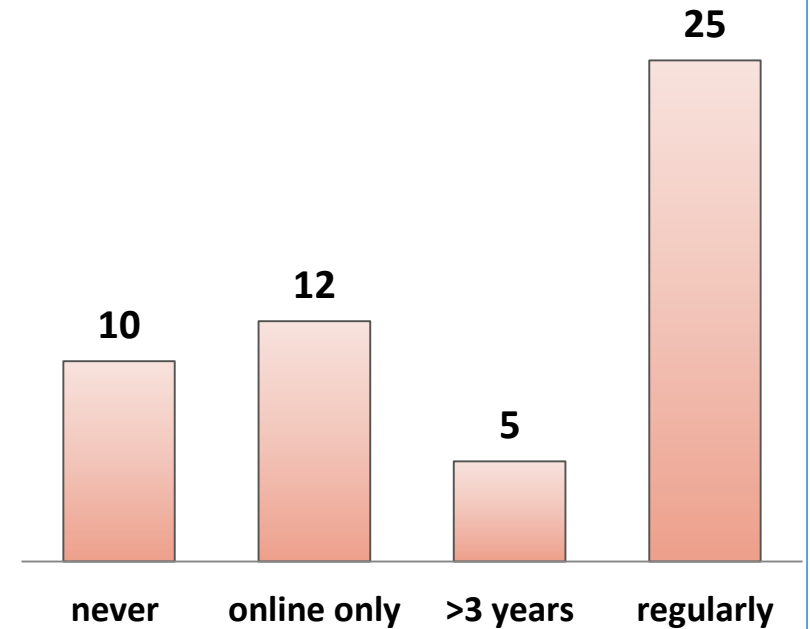
Data review

- 52 individuals to date
- 67% (35/52) previously PrEP Naïve
- >52% (27/52) had either NEVER accessed services /not accessed for >3 years (including online testing)
- -interestingly 11/25 who regularly accessed, had never used PrEP.

Previous sexual health access

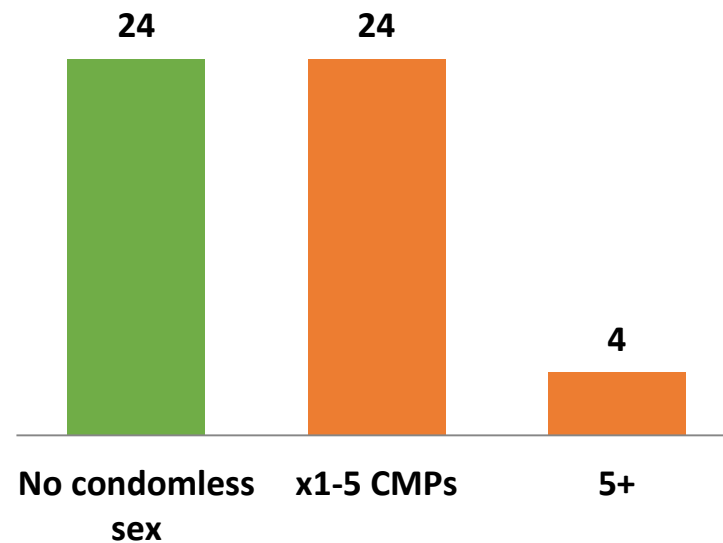




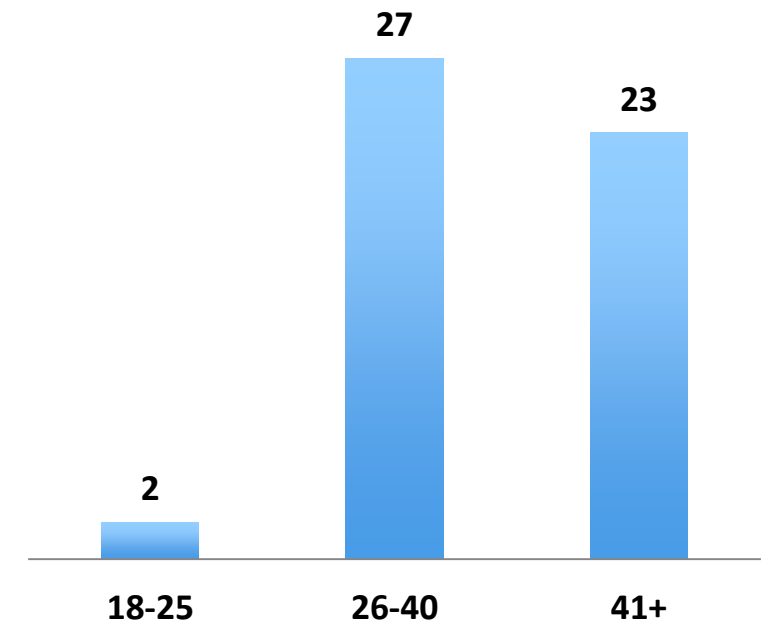
Data review

- >50% (28/52) reported condomless sex in the past 3/12 with 1-5 CMP's
- 41/52 (79%) were over the age of 30
- X1 person started on PEPSE, then followed PEP-PrEP pathway
