- 52 individuals to date
- 67% (35/52) previously PrEP Naïve
- >52% (27/52) had either NEVER accessed services /not accessed for >3 years (including online testing)
- -interestingly 11/25 who reguarly accessed, had never used PrEP.









Data review

- >50% (28/52) reported condomless sex in the past 3/12 with 1-5 CMP's
- 41/52 **(79%)** were over the age of 30
- X1 person started on PEPSE, then followed PEP-PrEP pathway







Whats next?

- Feedback /evaluation from current users
- incorporate "pop up model" across the city, continuing with collaborative community based working
- Reach other cohorts of people across the city e.g homelessness/sex workers etc.
- Help stop HIV transmission
